



Location and Transportation

Located in south-central Texas, Brenham is the county seat of Washington County. Perfectly positioned in the Texas Triangle at the intersection of US Highway 290 and State Highway 36, Brenham is midway between two megapolitan cities – Houston and Austin – both just over an hour's drive away. Brenham is also located just south of College Station and within easy access to San Antonio, Dallas, and Fort Worth.
