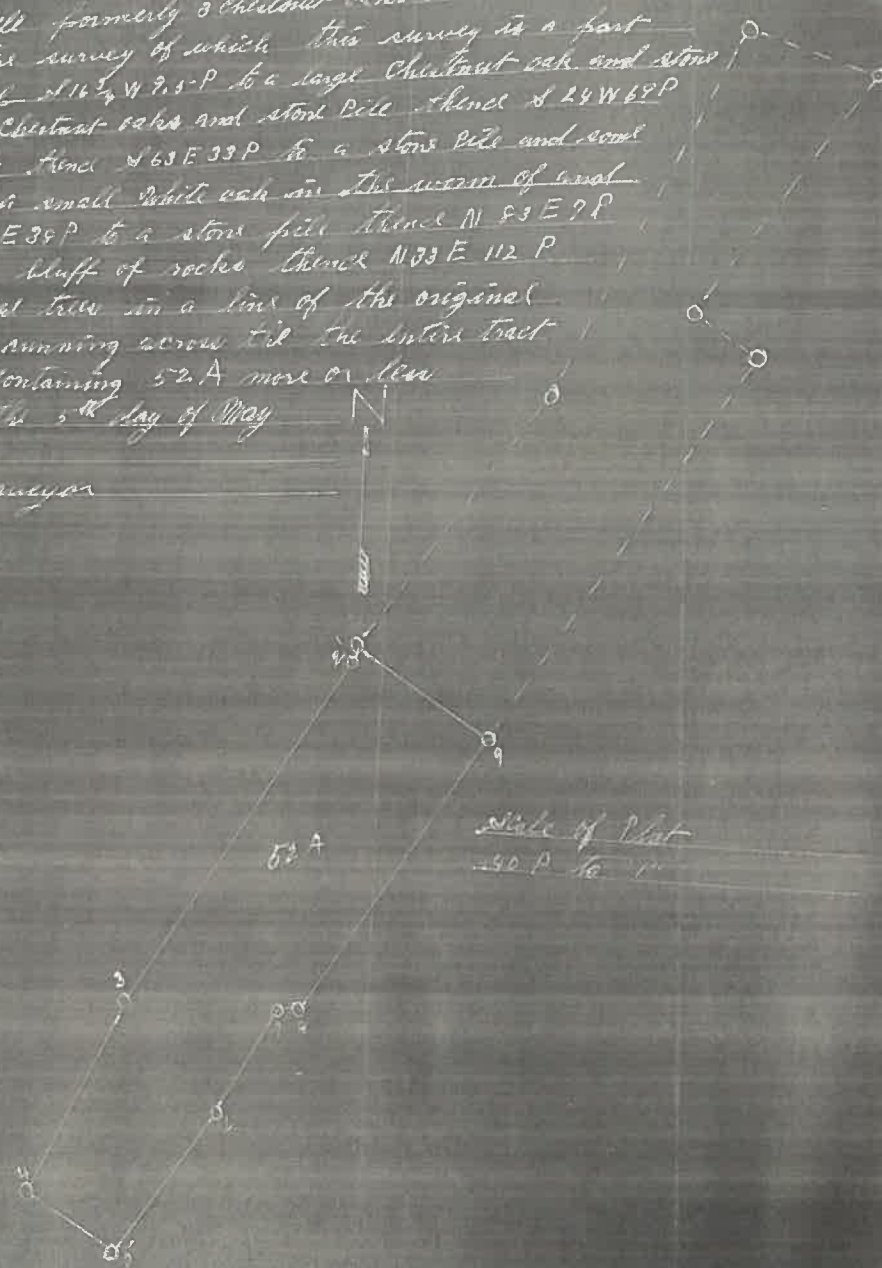

By request of Mr. Baker and John Wallis. I have this day made a survey of part of a tract of land containing 100 A more or less situate in Gore District of Hampshire County No. 22 on the North West side of Spring Gap Mt. adjoining the land of J. Post Miller and others and is described as follows:
Beginning at a stone pile formerly a chestnut oak on the west side of said Mt. the 3rd corner to the entire survey of which this survey is a part thence with line of the original of 16 1/2 W 7.5 P to a large chestnut oak and stone pile thence S 32 1/2 W 132 P to 2 chestnut oaks and stone pile thence S 29 W 68 P to 2 chestnut oaks and stone pile thence S 63 E 33 P to a stone pile and some small white oak in the corner of an old stone fence thence N 29 E 38 P to a stone pile thence N 53 E 7 P to a chestnut oak on top of a bluff of rocks thence N 33 E 112 P to a stone pile and some small trees in a line of the original survey thence leaving it and running across it the entire tract N 52 W 61 P to the beginning containing 52 A more or less.
This survey made this the 5th day of May 1906.
