Why Sherman


TI selects Sherman for \$29 billion chip factory

Texas Instruments has selected Sherman to host a 4.7-million-square-foot semiconductor fabrication plant. The facility will employ more than 3,000 people and contribute billions of dollars to the Grayson County economy.

Apple bringing more jobs, and investment to Sherman Apple came to Sherman in 2017 through the company's Advanced Manufacturing Fund, which helped transform a 700,000-square-foot building into a high-tech the manufacturing facility, creating hundreds of local jobs.

Sherman wins new \$5B GlobiTech semiconductor manufacturing facility

Sherman just won another high-prole multi-billion-dollar silicon wafer plant for its city, according to a news release. Texas Governor Greg Abbott announced today that GlobiTech will build an additional manufacturing facility in Sherman that will provide silicon epitaxy products and services for the company. The project could create 1,500 new jobs and potentially generate up to \$5 billion.




What's going on with the Dallas North Tollway..?

ne future Dallas North Tollway Phase 4 project will extend the tollway 13.7 miles north of U.S. 380. When this expansion is complete, it will provide a direct link between downtown Dallas and growing areas in Collin, Denton, and Grayson counties. What's the current status of the Dallas North Tollway Expansion? DNT Phase 4 began in February 2020. The Phase 4 project will extend the tollway 13.7 miles north of US 380. When this extension is complete, it will provide a direct link between downtown Dallas and growing areas in Collin, Denton, and Grayson counties. Phase 4 extension that straddles the Collin-Denton county line from FM 428 in Collin County to the Grayson County line. The county alignment provides a greater economic development benefit for most of the region, requires less right of way, and follows an existing county road system.

<u>Is the Dallas North Tollway going through Denison, TX?</u>

The Texas Department of Transportation is currently performing a study on the expansion of the Dallas North Tollway through Gunter, TX, and into Denison, TX. The proposed project would extend the proposed tollway 37 miles and provide traffic relief to US 75. Dallas-Fort Worth is projected to expand north and this project would accommodate that shift, provide an alternative for truck traffic and provide an easier access to Sherman, Denison, and Lake Texama.





SURVEY / COUNTY DETAILS

GRAYSON COUNTY

Grayson County is a county in the U.S. state of Texas. As of the 2020 census, its population was 135,543. The county seat is Sherman. The county was founded in 1846 and is named after Peter Wagener Grayson, an attorney general of the Republic of Texas. Grayson County is included in the Sherman-Denison metropolitan statistical area, which is also included in the Dallas-Fort Worth-Arlington, combined statistical area. It is also part of the Texama region, with proximity to Lake Texama and the Red River.







GUNTER, TEXAS


