IMPROVEMENTS

The main house is of block construction with a metal roof, circa 1970s which has 3 bedrooms and 3 baths offering privacy for everyone. This easy maintenance home uses propane for the refrigerator and gas stove, as well as unique built-in ceiling lights. A large bunkroom on the west side of the home can accommodate guests or hunters with ease. Breezes, beauty and stars are enjoyed from the large screened front porch that provides further casual relaxed living space. Perfect for a sleep area, you can glance out at the firepit and across a small pond that is an attraction for wildlife. Nearby is a 3-sided equipment shed and a metal garage with double overhead doors and carport. Supportive structures include a generator building with generator plus a metal shipping container for extra storage. The ranch is low barb wire fenced. All feeders and hunting blinds are included.



WATER

Near the house is a water well believed to be 422 feet deep that was drilled in 2013 and is both electric and solar. There are 2 pilas and a 300-gallon water storage tank that supplies the improvements. There is a second, non-working well. There are several water storage tanks and troughs.

UTILITIES

Solar, propane and optional generator.
