S. 28 09'40"E 94.30' to a point; thence

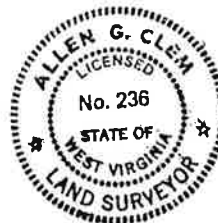
N. 61 12'20"E 37.19' to a point; thence

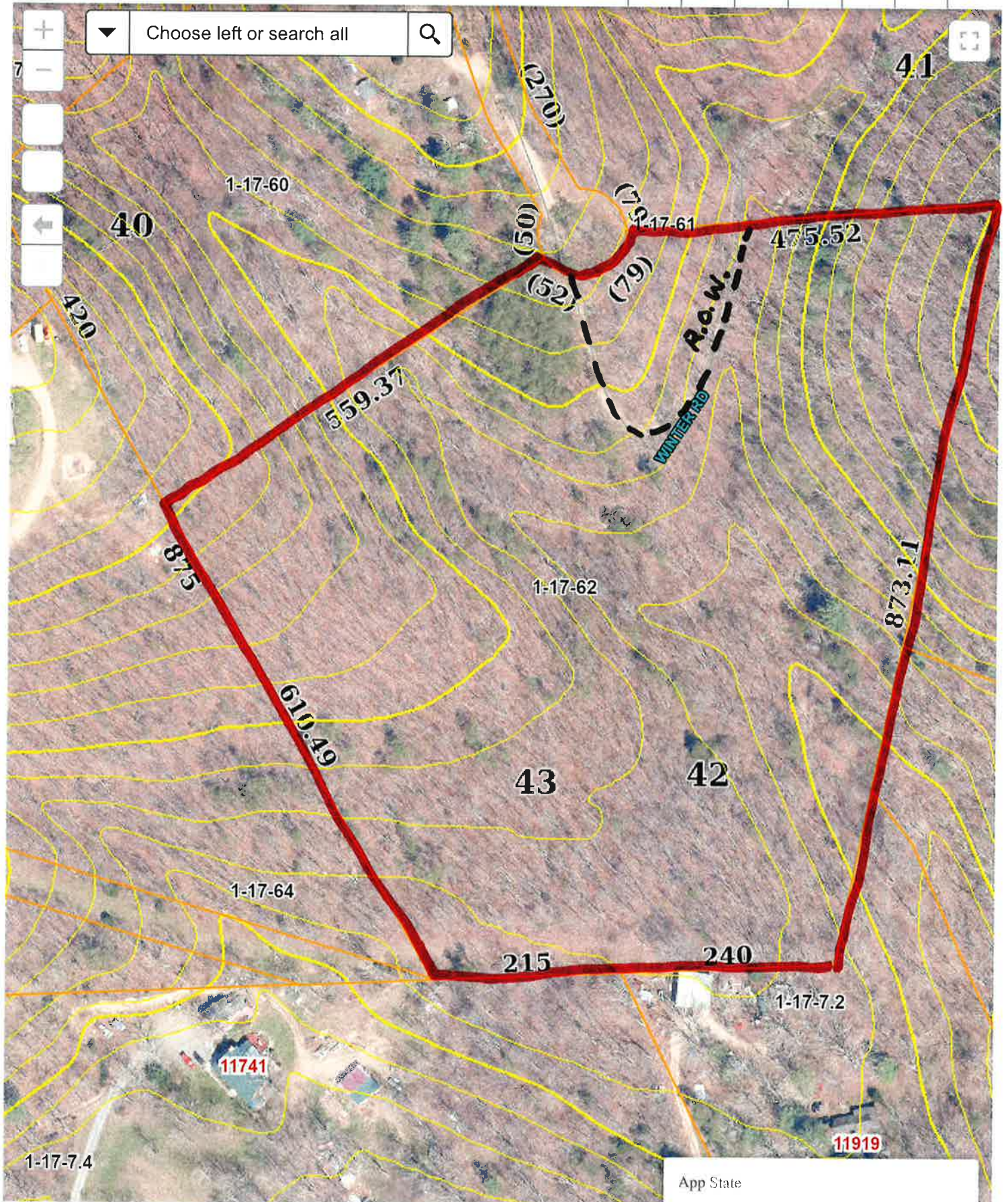
N. 32 29'30"E 121.42' to a point; thence
