

Starr by partition deed executed contemporaneously herewith, and to the heirs, devisees and assigns of said grantees, a private right of way easement thirty (30) feet in width extending from U. S. Highway 287 along the south boundary line of the below described tract of land to and across the 125.47 acre tract deeded from Thomas J. Starr, et ux to Alonzo Starr dated September 17, 1912 and Recorded in Vol. 111, Page 122 of the Deed Records of Anderson County, Texas, said right of way being as platted by R. J. Reed, Reg. Pub.
