WHEREAS, by final decree of the 37th Judicial District Court of Bexar County, in Cause No. 77-CI-13052, In Re: The Adjudication of Water Rights in the Upper Guadalupe River Segment of the Guadalupe River Basin, dated November 12, 1979, a right was recognized under Claim 1788 authorizing Carolee Ewing Youngblood to appropriate waters of the State of Texas as set forth below;

NOW, THEREFORE, this certificate of adjudication to appropriate waters of the State of Texas in the Guadalupe River Basin is issued to Carolee Ewing Youngblood, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. USE

Owner is authorized to divert and use not to exceed 14 acre-feet of water per annum from the North Fork of the Guadalupe River for municipal use within a tract of land located in the Charles Eller Survey 634, Abstract 134, Kerr County, Texas, said tract being described as follows:

- BEGINNING at a point in the center of the North Fork Guadalupe River, said point being on North line of Survey 634 and being East of the Northwest corner of Survey 634;
- (2) THENCE East, 766.0 varas;
- (3) THENCE S 45°E, 267.8 varas;
- (4) THENCE S 48°25'W, 214.5 varas;
- (5) THENCE S 48°E, 220.8 varas to a point in North line of Highway 1340;
- (6) THENCE S 84°40'W, 237 varas to the center of the North Fork of the Guadalupe River;
- (7) THENCE up said river with the meanders of its center as follows:

N 52°30'W, 190 varas; N 42°31'W, 205.2 varas; N 43°W, 210 varas; N 68°30'W, 88.6 varas; N 72°W, 128.8 varas; N 83°W, 82 varas to the place of beginning. (acreage out of Survey 634)

2. DIVERSION

A. Location:

At a point on the northeast bank of the North Fork of the Guadalupe River which is S 53°W, 1940 feet from the northeast corner of the Charles Eller Survey 634, Abstract 134, Kerr County, Texas.

B. Maximum Rate: 0.2 cfs (100 gpm).

3. PRIORITY

The time priority of owner's right is 1945.

The locations of pertinent features related to this certificate are shown on Page 2 of the Guadalupe River Certificates of Adjudication Maps, copies of which are located in the offices of the Texas Department of Water Resources and the office of the County Clerk.

This certificate of adjudication is issued subject to all terms, conditions and provisions in the final decree of the 37th Judicial District Court of Bexar

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County, in Cause No. 77-CI-13052, <u>In Re: The Adjudication of Water Rights in the Upper Guadalupe River Segment of the Guadalupe River Basin</u>, dated November 12, 1979, and supersedes all rights of the owner asserted in that cause.

This certificate of adjudication is issued subject to senior and superior water rights in the Guadalupe River Basin.
