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
#### Ranch



Five miles northeast of Melstone, MT on Highway 12 sets the Newman ranch consisting of 3,334 acres deeded of which 381 acres are crop land.

The ranch is on the banks of the Musselshell river which supplies 195 shares, shares cost \$50.00 per share, of water thru the Delphi-Melstone water users association.

The owner rates the ranch at 130 pair of cattle.



Owners are presently irrigating 105 acres with a six tower Zimmatic pivot new in 2018, 40 acres with two wheel lines, 32 acres with two wheel lines, 81 acres of flood and 120 acres of dry land hay, the irrigated hay is cut three

times/year and produces five ton / acre with the dry land producing two ton /acre. The owner did plant corn one year on 88 acres of

irrigated and produced 27 ton /acre.





all water to this system thus alleviating the need for the shared well. Buttes Coulee is a seasonal creek, with one tank supplying water to the west side of the river.

Water for all the homes, corrals and water tanks comes from a shared well it is on a neighbors ranch and all easements are in place. The owner has applied for water from the river and will complete this process plus convert



There are six pastures on the east side of the river and one pasture on the west side, the river has a couple of gravel bottom shallow crossing that allow the ranch access to both sides






Along with a 30 x 60 livestock shed, 32 x 112 barn which is an old railroad depot building, 88 x 104 pole shed/barn built in 2017 and a 108 x 24 open faced shelter built in 2018 and a great set of modern corrals completes the improvements.

houses.
