Appropriate information has been submitted to the delegated authority of the Board of Health and as such, the sanitary restrictions have been addressed with the following provisions:

Lots 5, 6, and 7 have severe limitations that may prevent further development and as such will require further test hole evaluation to determine acceptability for subsurface sewage disposal.

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, and 9 are suitable for standard subsurface sewage disposal systems. Test hole evaluations are on record in the District Seven Health Department files.
