





## ~Property Details~

J Wrigley Vineyards is offering 169 acres\* of vine land extending from the top of Cherry Hill Road all the way east to Gopher Valley Rd. The 169 acres will be partitioned out of their 202 total acres owned (leaving an inactive rock quarry, which is not for currently for sale). If desired, an additional partition can create two parcels, a west half and an east half. These can be sold separately or together.\*

Parcel 1: 19394 Cherry Hill Rd, the west half, will include 89 acres, the 3,760 sf Commercial Winery building with office, a custom-finished Tasting Room with kitchen and guest quarters\*\* and outside guest patio with mountain and valley views. Surrounding this is their award-winning 11 acres of vineyard, and an estimated 47 ac plant-able, currently in grassfields which are cleared and ready to plant. This parcel sits at 640' to 720' elevation, SE/S/SW aspect and gently sloped for easy farming. Soils are mostly Jory/Bellpine with some Witzel— and Gellatly-Dixonville, for a mix of marine sedimentary and volcanic soils. Existing trellising infrastructure allows for expansion of additional vineyards. Planted in Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay and Riesling (see vineyard map.)

Parcel 2: The east half can be accessed directly both from Gopher Valley Rd. and Cherry Hill Rd. This parcel will include 80 acres, an existing residence, 1-acre vineyard, 4 acres plant-able and 32 acres cleared. The 2006, 3-bedroom 2-bath manufactured home of 2,173 sf, that has panoramic views. There are many other view building sites. The desirable SE slope has an elevation from 300'-700', and volcanic, Jory and Gellatly soils. Site was logged and cleared 3 years ago, stumps are ready for removal. Year-round Deer Creek flows through the southern part, along the private road which passes over a 35-ton bridge at the property entrance. Once complete, this private road will provide a direct connection up to the winery from the many near-by vineyards and tasting rooms in the McMinnville AVA.



# arine dimentary

Bellpine

Often described as dark color, bold, cola, coffee, dark color, black fruit or chocolate.

Very dry, almost like baby powder. Compost and cover crops are essential to enrich the soil.

Dark colored earth that results from a lack of minerals.

Best wines will come from older vines with more established root systems that have gone deep in search of water and minerals. Wines are typically slow-developing and need to age longer.

**TASTE** 

Often described as bright red, perfumy, sweet, red-fruit or mixed berry.

Volcanic

FEEL

Tends to be finely grained, but holds together to retain water and reflect heat.

SEE

Contains high proportions of iron, resulting in dark- or red-colored dirt.

**EFFECT** 

High elevation vineyards have incredible acid structure and yield wines of depth, richness of fruit with aging potential. Wines are typically bright fruit and demonstrate great potential at a younger age.

### **HISTORY**

Western Oregon was once the floor of an 8,000-foot-deep sea. Starting about 15 million years ago, the Pacific and North American tectonic plates collided, lifting up this ocean floor and creating the Coast Range and the Cascade Mountains. The resulting soil is composed of the marine sediment of that former seafloor. As the collisions continued, the hills of the Willamette Valley were formed, with the top layer of volcanic soil exposed in some places and the lower layer of sedimentary soil revealed in others.
