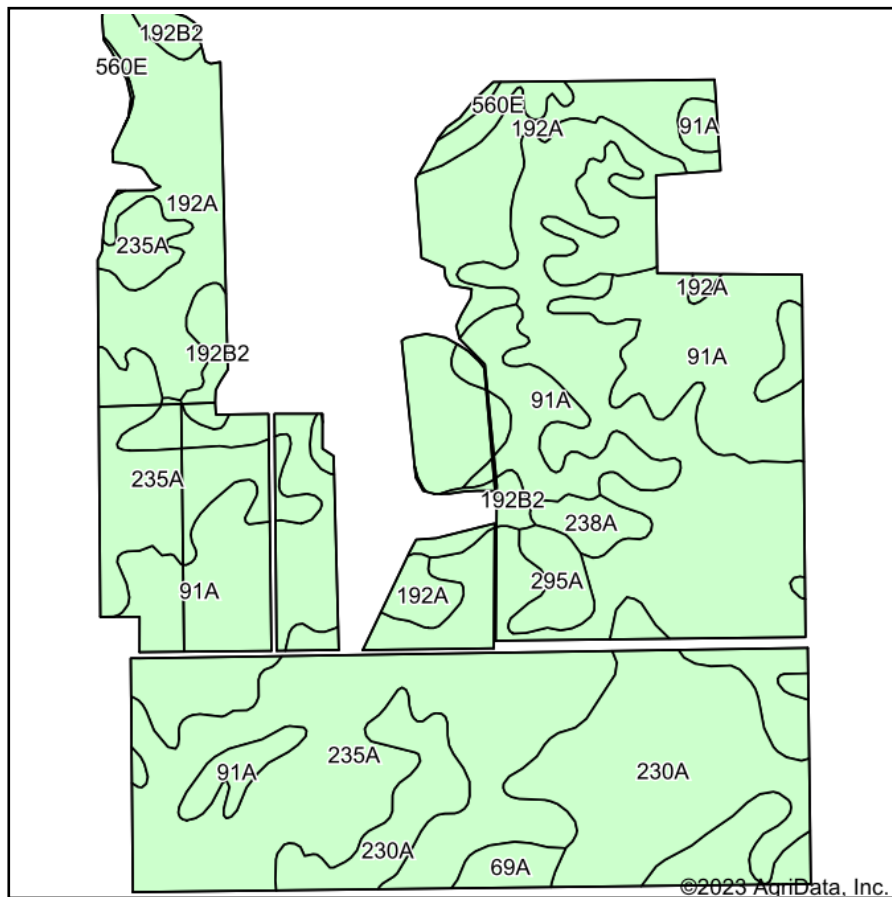
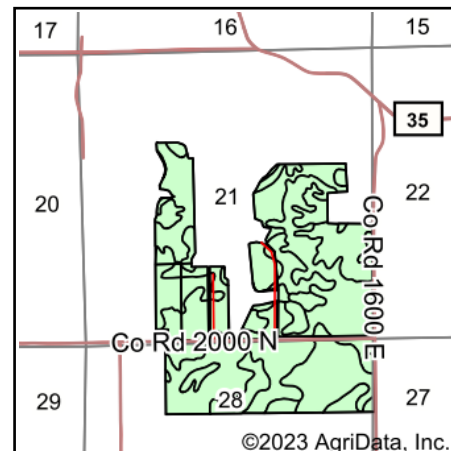


Crescent City Soils Map
