

ACREAGE. 661.69± Acres (being 652.22± contiguous acres and 9.47± on the Nueces River)

LAND TYPE. Live Water

TAX EXEMPTION. Wildlife Management Tax Exemption

LOCATION. Approximately 6 miles South of Camp Wood, Texas — Uvalde County 35± miles Northwest of Uvalde

ACCESS. Paved frontage on County Road 416. Heavy-duty electric gated entrances. All-weather caliche driveway. Black gravel drive leading to the improvements. Man-made trails and abundant natural trails created from heavy wildlife traffic throughout the ranch.

LAND. Hill Country Ranch and River property. An excellent spread of Texas soil ideal for recreation and hunting, stargazing, fishing and swimming. Riparian habitat along the Nueces River frontage, level and gently rolling bottom lands, steep and rugged mountain range. In a nutshell, this ranch has all types of topographical ranges from mountain top to river bottom, which is pretty neat-o—it's basically 'The Geology of Texas'!

WATER.

RIVER FRONTAGE

600± Feet of frontage on the sought-after Nueces River. Strong flowing, crystal clear with deeper areas for jumping in to swim or fish and shallower areas perfect for wading and setting out the river chairs. Tube or kayak down river for a 4± hour floating experience.

WATER WELLS & WATER STORAGE

Four (4) water wells—One (1) Aermotor windmill
There are two (2) water wells located near the improvements and
two (2) water wells within the ranch. The well that is operable by
windmill, is currently inoperable. Water storage tanks.

XX LAKE SITE

Excellent opportunity to construct a customized lake at the base of the Rawhide Mountain range that is fed from run-off tributaries.

WILDLIFE. Abundant Axis Deer, sizable Whitetail Bucks, Aoudad, Hog, Turkey, Dove, Quail, other Woodland and Songbirds, rare sightings of Blackbuck, Sika and Fallow. Bass, Perch, Catfish and Waterfowl.

VEGETATION. Lined with Sycamore and aquatic plants along the river region. Studded with large Live Oak and Pecan shading the improvements. The ranch land and canyons are dominated with Spanish Oak, Blue Oak, Live Oak, Guajillo, Juniper Cedar, Mountain Laurel, Agarita and Persimmon.

Blanketed with native grasses and brush.

SOILS. The area along the river is underlain with Uvalde clay loam, Olmos soils, River wash and Dev soils while the majority of the ranch is based with Real and Eckrant soils, rock outcrop and Karett clay—all good for pasture, range, recreation, woodland, wildlife food and cover.

POWER. Power is on the ranch.

Landscaped and manicured entrances showcasing the Hill Country ranch lifestyle at its best. The frontage of the ranch is accented with quality pipe rail fencing, beautiful stone work and intricate detail work on the heavy-duty metal electric gated entrances.
