Each City and County have different inspection requirements. If you are required to do an inspection our office will email you the information.

For properties within the *City of Wichita* the requirements are:

- 1. Any type of water well must have a Title Transfer Inspection performed prior to the transfer of the property. The property owner is required to notify the City of Wichita, Department of Environmental Services at the time the property is listed for sale and is responsible for the \$125.00 inspection fee. If the water well on the property is used for personal use (drinking, cooking, or bathing), the well must also be sampled to ensure that the water is potable. A sample fee of \$25.00 per sample will be charged, in addition to the inspection fee. If the well is for irrigation purposes only, the water sample is optional. The City of Wichita will bill for the inspection and sample.
- 2. All water wells must be located a minimum of 25 feet from a foundation that has been treated for termites (or will require treatment prior to transfer of ownership) with a subsurface pressurized application of a pesticide. Existing wells may remain in a basement so long as they are not within 10 feet of the main sewer line or within 25 feet of foundation if no termite treatment has occurred or is currently needed.
