



Situated in Section 24, Town 5, Range 2, Milford Township, Butler County, Ohio and being more particularly bounded and described as follows.

Beginning at a point in the grantors south line where it intersects the center of the Norfolk & Western Railroad, found by measuring from the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of said section North 0° 38' 23" East along the center of Hamilton-Eaton Road 299.38 feet to a point;

Thence North 62° 06' 48" West along the center of said road 180.12 feet to a point;

Thence North 59° 53' 42" West along the center of said road 831.97 feet to a P.K. Nail (found);

Thence North 30° 04' 32" East 443.22 feet to a iron pipe (found);

Thence North 89° 45' 26" East 71.05 feet to the aforesaid point:

THENCE FROM THE BEGINNING THUS FOUND

North 41° 30' West along the center of the Norfolk & Western Railroad a distance of 1734.91 feet to a point;

Thence North 48° 30' East (passing a iron pin set at 30.00 feet) a distance of 942.79 feet to a point in the grantors east line (witnessed by an iron pin set bearing South 48° 30' West 25.00 feet);

Thence South 56° 00' East a distance of 803.23 feet to a point in Seven Mile Creek;

Thence South 4° 00' East with said creek 263.89 feet to a point (witnessed by a iron pin set on the west bank of said creek bearing South 83° 30' West 46.35 feet);

Thence North 83° 30' East with said creek 158.25 feet to a point;

Thence South 47° 00' 58" East with said creek 376.20 feet to a point;

Thence South 13° 58' 12" East with said creek 278.53 feet to a point;

Thence South 19° 00' 37" West and leaving said creek (passing a iron pin set a 263.05 feet) a distance of 741.12 feet to a stone (found);

Thence South 89° 45' 26" West 499.10 feet to the point of beginning containing 46.222 acres of land and being subject to the legal right-of-way for the Norfolk & Western Railroad and all other easements and restrictions of record.

ACCESS EASEMENT
