From the intersection of US Hwy 165 and LA Hwy 113 in Glenmora, LA, go south on US Hwy 165 and travel a distance of approximately 0.5 miles and then turn left (east) on Turkey Creek Road, a Rapides Parish public road. Travel on Turkey Creek Road for approximately 0.94 miles and then turn right (south) on Evangeline Road, a Rapides Parish public road. Travel on Evangeline Road for approximately 2.35 miles and turn left (east) on Oil Field Road, a Rapides

Parish public road. Travel on Oil Field Road for approximately 1.35 miles and turn right (south) on Babb Road, a Rapides Parish public road. Travel on Babb Road for approximately 0.75 miles to arrive at a gated company road on the left (east). Travel through the gate for approximately 2.0 miles across a private company gravel road to arrive at

the northwest corner of the subject.

Navigation to plots was by GPS precision. Listed below are the estimated timber volumes by product class for each timber stand.
