

SANITARY REGULATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Dan Walker Subdivision

The subject subdivision/lot split has been reviewed for sanitary restrictions described in Idaho Code Section 50-1326. The following comments are intended to inform and educate all parties as to the sewage disposal and/or potable water situations particular to this development.

Sewage disposal:

Testholes for the original Rock Point subdivision and for the sewage disposal permit on Lot A indicate adequate soil conditions exist for Lots B-D. Individual testholes should be reviewed prior to sewage permit issuance to address site specific soils.

Potable water:

The lots will be served by the existing well. This well appears to have adequate volume and acceptable water quality.

These lots are subject to all applicable public health and sanitation needs and regulations, as well as county ordinances. No inhabitable dwelling will be constructed without a valid sewage disposal permit.

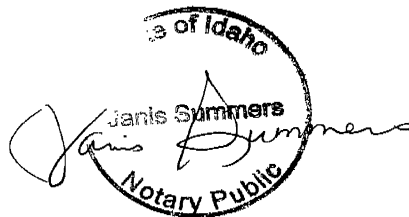
