2. Privies and portable restrooms shall maintain minimum setbacks as specified below.

- 3. Privies and portable restrooms shall be constructed to meet the requirements of SPS 391 and shall be maintained in a clean condition so that insects and rodents cannot enter the vault. The contents of any privy or portable restroom shall be disposed of in accordance with NR 113, Wis. Adm. Code.
- 4. The storage chamber of a vaulted privy shall conform to the requirements of SPS 384.25 and shall have a minimum storage capacity of 200 gallons or one cubic yard. The storage chamber of a portable restroom shall be watertight and the entire floor and side walls to a height of not less than four inches shall be of a material impervious to water.
- 5. This agreement shall be binding on the owner, their heirs and assignees. This document shall be recorded by the register of deeds in a manner that allows its existence to be determined by reference to the property where the privy or portable restroom is utilized.
