

Topography

The topography of the Bluebonnet Creek Ranch is made up of creeks (Duck Creek and W Prong Duck Creek) with big cottonwood trees, along with mesquite cover up on the tops. Some old cultivated and CRP ground allows some open country to see wildlife. The ranch is fenced on all sides. The ranch is in excellent condition with a good turf of grass. The current owner has not run cows in several years. Elevations on the ranch range from 2,021' on the North end to 1,980' on Duck Creek. The average annual rainfall for Kent County is 22.91 inches.


















Fencing

The fencing on the ranch is in decent shape, there may be a little work needed on the north side.

Water Features

Water on the Bluebonnet Creek Ranch is considered to be excellent with two electric submersible water wells. Owner in the past irrigated 5 acres of alfalfa and 2 acres of watermelons. Plus, during the cooler months, Duck Creek will have live water in it.











Hunting • Recreation

Hunting on the ranch is considered to be good with game species that include whitetail deer, dove, quail, hogs, turkey, and waterfowl. The current owner has taken pride in creating a better-than-normal wildlife habitat. It is common to see 5- 10 coveys of birds while touring this property. The cottonwood trees on Duck Creek provide great roosting cover for the local turkey.




Remarks


