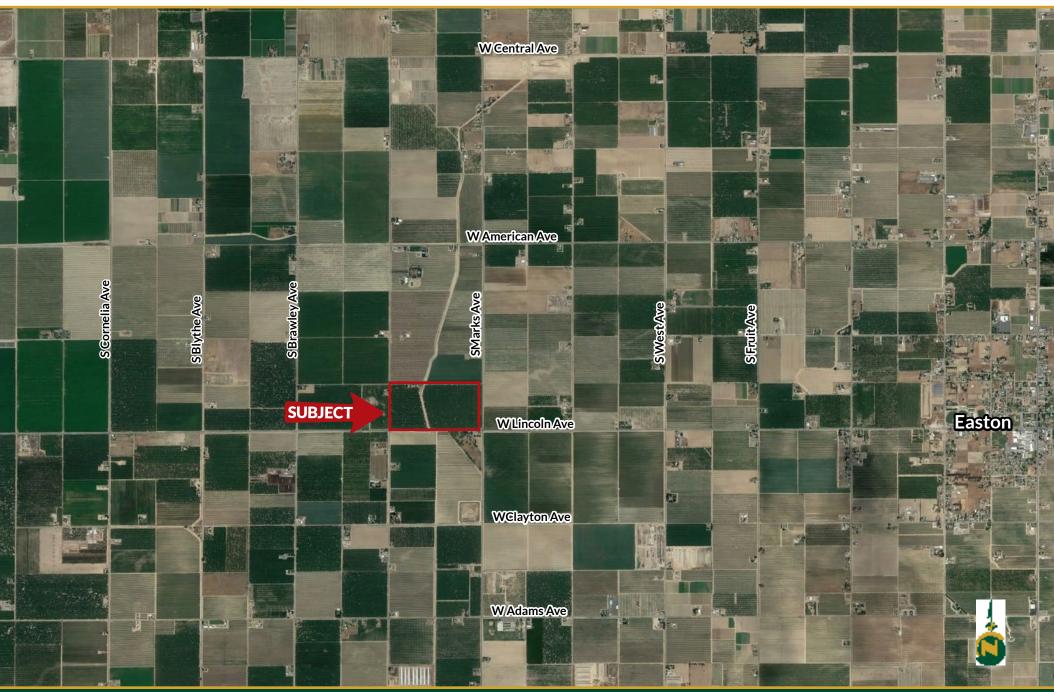

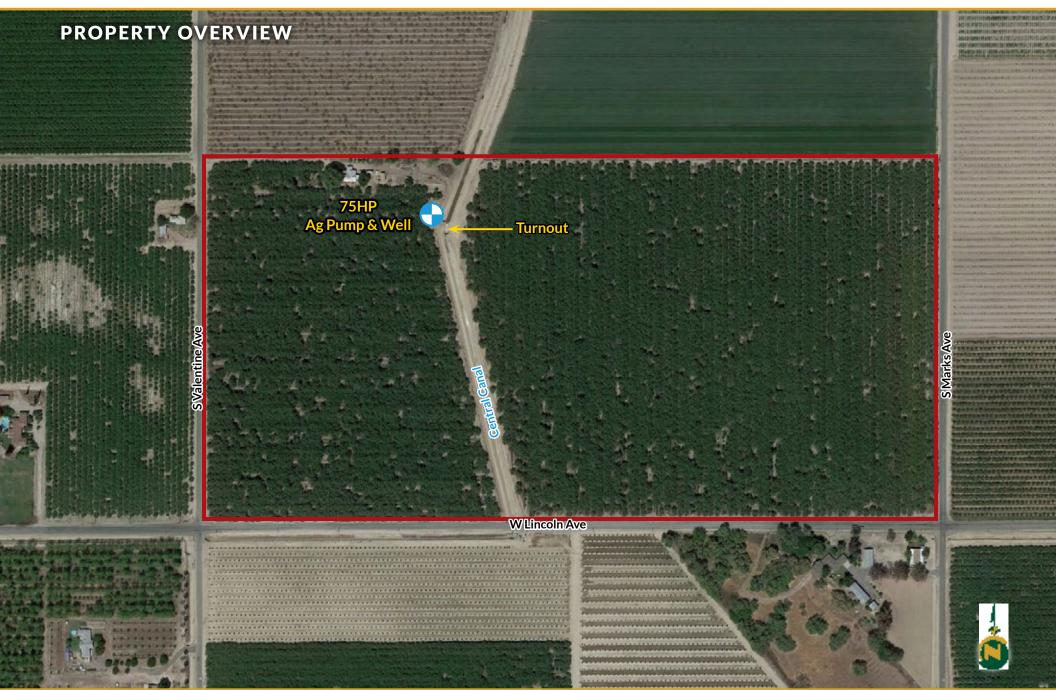

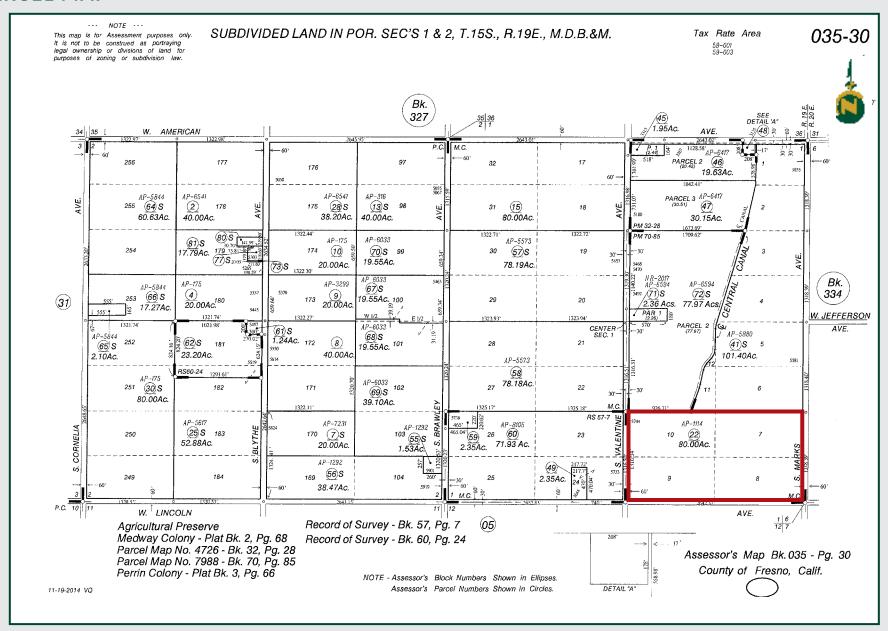
## **SOILS MAP**
