

Description of Survey for Sewell Creek Land Management, LLC

10.00 Acres

A tract of land situate on the waters of Wolf Creek of New River in Forest Hill District, Summers County, West Virginia and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a %" rebar found on the western side of an existing 30' right-of-way, a corner to Kevin A. and Joyce A. Pruitt's 5 acres and Ralph F. and Janet Richmond's 94.628 acres, from which a %" rebar found, a corner to Sewell Creek Land Management, LLC's 122.312 acres, of which this tract is a part, said 94.628 acres, and said 5 acres, bears S 36°42'10" W at 198.99', thence leaving said 5 acres and with said right-of-way for three (3) lines and with said 94.628 acres for eleven (11) lines

N 28°05'10" E 26.66' to a point, thence

N 08°44'40" E 47.80' to a point in the centerline of Wolf Creek, thence leaving said right-of-way and with said centerline of Wolf Creek for eight (8) lines

S 86°05'30" E 182.36' to a point, thence

S 84°04'40" E 221.86' to a point, thence

S 88°36'10" E 77.58' to a point, thence

N 73°00'20" E 46.31' to a point, thence

S 77°21'40" E 98.79' to a point, a corner to Myrtle Francis Harvey's 37 acres, thence leaving said Wolf Creek and said 94.628 acres, and with said 37 acres for three (3) lines

S 06°17'30" W 34.68' to a 5/8" rebar with pointers found, thence

S $06^{\circ}09'00"$ W 288.21' to a 34" x 30" rebar with a $2\frac{1}{2}"$ aluminum cap (34" rebar hereafter) set in a box elder stump found, thence

N 82°48'30" E 269.32' to a ¾" rebar set, a new division corner to said 122.312 acres, from which a 40" dead white oak snag ir fence corner found, a corner to said 37 acres and said 122.312 acres, bears N 82°48'30" E at 676.01', thence leaving said 37 acres and though said 122.312 acres for three (3) lines

S 19°16'10" E 641.16' to a 3/4" rebar set, thence

S 70°12'40" W 84.21' to a 3/4" rebar set, thence

N 53°22'30" W 1108.57' to five maples (12", 10", 7", 5", and 3") found, a corner to said 5 acres, from which a $\frac{5}{8}$ " rebar with a cap found, a corner to said 5 acres and 122.312 acres, bears S 03°53'30" E at 232.61', thence with said 5 acres for two (2) lines

N 04°36'10" W 138.67' to a fence post found with a rebar set beside it, thence

N 79°13'10" W 390.17' to the Point of Beginning, having an area of 10.00 acres as surveyed on the grid north meridian as by THB Land Management, LLC in March, 2024 and shown on a plat entitled "Plat of Survey for Sewell Creek Land Management, LLC" attached hereto, and by reference, made a part of this survey.

Being a tract of land described as 122.312 acres conveyed to Sewell Creek Land Management, LLC from Joseph W. and Jackie A. Dean by a deed dated July 22, 2022 and of record in the Office of the Clerk of Summers County in Deed Book 279 at page 34.
