- Exposed wood and logs are stained with an iron oxide treatment (a mix of water, vinegar, and steel wool).
- Board and batten exterior is stained with light brown board called Van Fleet 1780.
- Standing seam metal roof installed with custom-built, heavy-duty snow clips.
- Wide plank interior floors are finished with clear latex designed to look like oil stain.

- Custom kitchen: light-filled, state-of-the-art, and fully equipped with ZLINE brand appliances, soapstone counters, floating shelves, KraftMaid cabinets, and scenic views.
