Surveyor's Description

THENCE North 59 degrees 38 minutes 00 seconds East for a distance of 1201.78 feet to a 2 inch cap on a 5/8 inch iron rod found on the south line of the said railroad right of way, being the most northern northeast corner of the said Choate Tracts and an

THENCE South 01 degrees 20 minutes 10 seconds West for a distance of 408.56 feet to a 2 inch cap on a 5/8 inch iron rod found, being an ell corner of the said Choate Tracts and a southwest corner of the said Oglesby Estate Tract.
