

POA Summary

- POA Dues: \$2,500 per year.
- Lots 1 & 2 used commercially / Lots 3 thru 7 used residentially or ag-use.

Summary of Residential Restrictions

- Design and construction of all structures must be approved by ACC;
- No further subdivision of any residential lot;
- No short-term rental (6-month rental minimum);
- Minimum size of "Main Dwelling" of 2,000 square feet;
- "Accessory Dwelling" size between 500 to 2,800 square feet;
- Up to two (2) "Accessory Buildings" (i.e. barn/workshop/carport);
 - Maximum accessory building size of 2,000 square feet
- Dwellings must be at least 100 feet from all property lines;
- Accessory buildings must be at least 50 feet from all property lines;
- Accessory dwellings and buildings must be behind the main dwelling;
- No hunting or firing of firearms;
- Livestock Rules:
 - Maximum of one (1) livestock unit per 2.5 acres.
 - One (1) Livestock Unit Equals:
 - One (1) horse / One (1) cattle/bovine / One (1) mule/donkey / Two (2) goats / Two (2) sheep.
 - Chickens don't count as livestock unit.
 - Maximum of five (5) per 2.5 acres.

• Summary of Commercial Restrictions:

- Design and construction of all structures must be approved by ACC;
- Minimum structure size of 2,000 square feet;
- Maximum structure height of 40';
- Exterior walls constructed of wood/stone/brick/metal/Hardie/cement;
- Driveway paving constructed of concrete/asphalt/paved brick;
- Roofing constructed of metal or tile only;
- No excessive or noxious sounds, odors or waste;
- No mobile home or RV parks;
- No junk/salvage/scrap/storage yards;
- No manufactured/mobile/modular structures;
- No structures or paving within 100' of back & side property lines;
- No tree removal within 100' of back property line;
- No access to driveway for residential lots;
- May be subdivided into 5.01 acres (or larger) lots;
