









LAND OVERVIEW

Located in Mercer County, MO, just South of Cainsville, lies this remarkable 160+/- acre recreational farm. The property is situated at the end of a private easement road in the heart of the section and is predominantly hardwood timber featuring a healthy stand of oaks, hickory and scattered walnut. A network of established, vehicle-friendly roads wind throughout the farm, providing easy access to four secluded food plots planted with a mix of clover, brassicas, and annual grains. Abundance of cover and habitat thanks to several years of TSI work. Additionally, all utilities are on site including electricity and water combined with an off-grid cabin. If you're searching for a secluded recreational tract with a strong trail camera history combined with prime whitetail habitat, then look no further.
