Hiking: South Central Tennessee has so much to offer outdoors enthusiasts, and hikers will not be disappointed in the beauty found at White Oak Falls. With over a thousand acres and 5 miles of roads and trails to explore, there are multiple ways to take advantage of all the property offers. For hikers and people wanting to enjoy the scenery, there are challenging trails chock full of rock formations, heart-pumping routes, and leisurely paths for those wishing to explore the terrain with family members and a more investigative eye.

Water Abounds and Nature: Outdoor enthusiasts and nature lovers will be delighted to revel in the backdrop while taking in the sounds and smells found throughout the 3 miles of streams and 7 waterfalls dotted among the trails. With water comes gorgeous blankets of moss, another special sight in the area! While touring White Oak Falls, you can encounter a stunning combination of topography, from old-growth forests of hardwood timber to hundreds of acres of fresh-scented plantation pines. - Pie-billed & Horned grebes
- Bufflehead, Mallard & Ruddy ducks
- Double-crested cormorant
- Great blue heron
- Bald eagles
