WHEREAS, Corsicand—Navarro County Developers, L.L.C. and VFMC, L.L.C. are the owners of that certain lot, tract or parcel of land situated in Navarro County, Texas out of the John Hamilton Survey, Abstract 381, the William Hamilton Survey, Abstract 373, and the Ransom Heaton Survey, Abstract 340, and being a part of Lot 19 and a part of the Reserve Area as shown on the plat of Beaton Lake Estates, an addition to the City of Corsicana, Texas, according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 5, at Page 33 of the Map Records of Navarro County, Texas, and being all of the called 102.77 acre First tract and all of the 15.006 acre Second tract conveyed to Stephen D. Lesser and Martin Soshtain by Stephen D. Lesser trustee by deed dated October 21, 1980 and recorded in Volume 945, Page 872 of the Navarro County Deed Records and all of a called 15.003 acre conveyed to the Hemmi Family trust by Robert A. Hemmi and wife Virginia C. Hemmi by deed dated July 2, 1993 and recorded in Volume 1268, Page 804 of the Navarro County Deed Records, all three referenced tracts now being the same property described as 132.315 acres of land conveyed to Coreicana—Navarro County Developers, L.L.C., by deed recorded in Volume 1555 at Page 516 of the Deed Records of Navarro County, Texas, and additionally all of the colled 20.004 acre tract of land conveyed to Factory Stores of America by deed recorded in Volume 1268 at Page 693 of the Deed Records of Navarro County, Texas, and being all of a tract of land described in a deed to VFMC, L.L.C., as recorded in Volume 1579, Page 79, of the Deed Records of Navarro County, Texas, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a 5/8" iron rod found in the Southeast right of way line of Interstate Highway No. 45 at the most Westerly Northwest corner of the Factory Stores of America Inc., 20.004 acre tract recorded in Volume 1268, Page 693 and at the North corner of the Corsican—Navarro County Developers, L.L.C., 132.315 acre tract;

THENCE North 23' 32' 00" East along the Southeast right of way of Interstate Highway No. 45 for a distance of 91.31 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found for corner;
