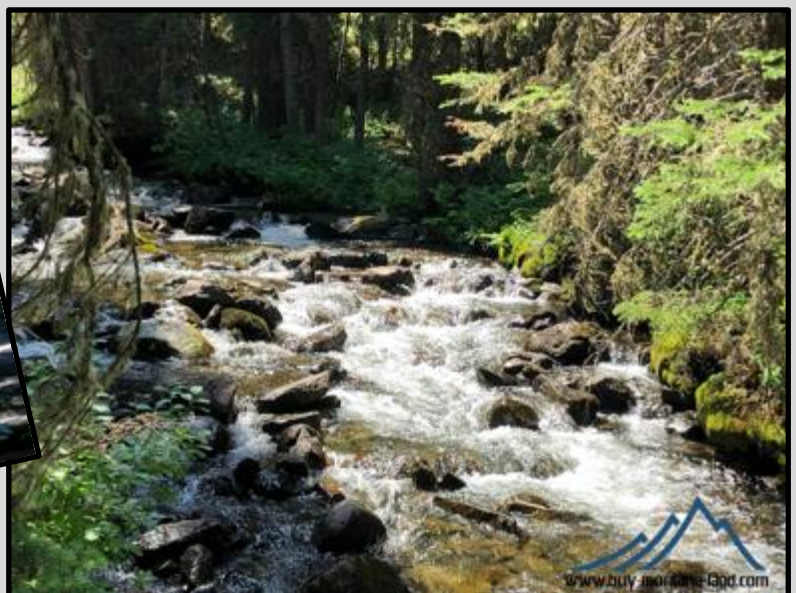

Build your cabin right near the edge of the South Boulder River where you can see the river and easily access the tumbling waters and hear the sounds of mother nature pouring by 24 hours a day/7 days a week. You can fish for cutthroat and brook trout right in the river on your very own property then go up and down the river onto all the National Forest lands and keep right on fishing. The river pours right out of numerous high mountain lakes that are chock full of trout. Lakes like Brannan Lake, Sailor Lake, Lake Louise, Lost Cabin Lake, Globe Lake and more are all here to be fished and enjoyed.



These are high mountain lakes that are pristine and picturesque with the mountain peaks jutting up right from their shores. It's the perfect background setting for your high mountain South Boulder River recreational property. And the property also has a fresh Montana mountain stream running right through it in addition to the river. Enjoy it all. Moose, elk, and mule deer call the property home, and the high mountain peaks hold mountain goats and even more wildlife. Being up at the higher elevations where the property sits, it's cooler here than down in the valley bottoms in the summer too. This is strictly an off the grid recreational property for summer and fall use as its way back in the mountains on a mountain road and gets too much snow for year-round living.
