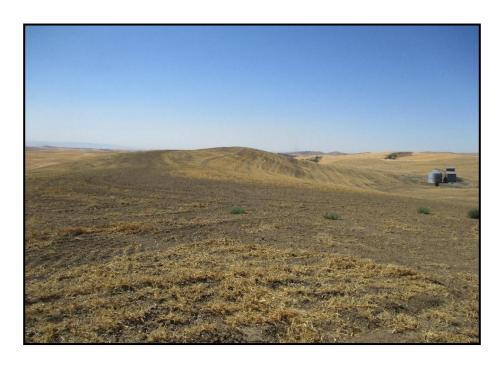

#### **PROPERTY DESCRIPTION**

Associated Appraisers of Walla Walla, LLC is pleased to present the offer for sale a property located north of Waitsburg in Columbia County.

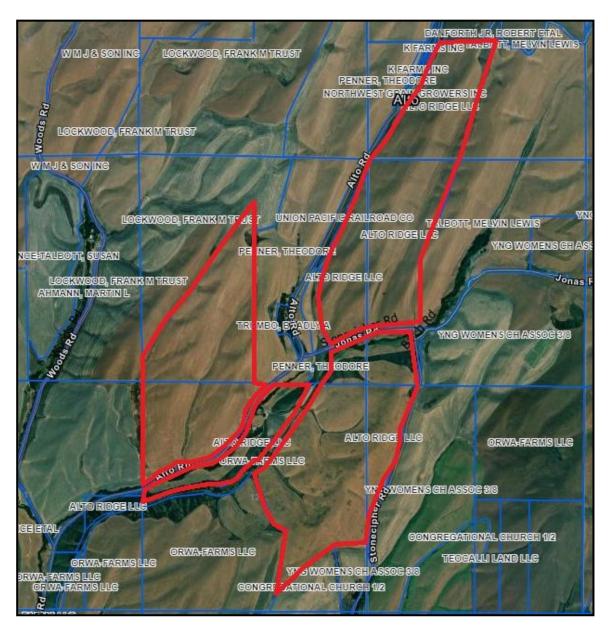
This farm is located about 10 miles northeast of Waitsburg, and about 14 miles northwest of the Dayton, primarily along the east and west sides of McKay Alto Road. It has a total of **948.26 acres** of which there are **891.84 tillable acres**.

The irregular shaped tracts are rolling in topography with some fairly level areas in the southwest portion of the farm near McKay Alto Road. The predominant soil types Athena silt loam. The average annual rainfall is 16 to 18 inches. Power is available to the tract. McKay Creek runs along the south side of McKay Alto Road in the southeastern area and is a year-round creek. The annual crop rotation is a three year rotation of winter wheat, spring wheat followed by peas, with the historic winter wheat yield at 87 bushels per acre, spring at 48 bushels per acre, and peas at 1,974 pounds.

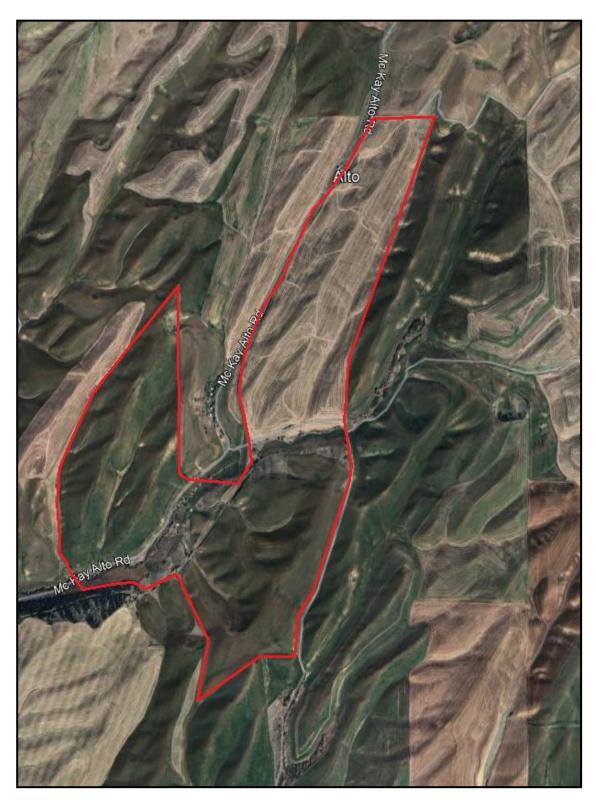


Facing South along the Northern Boundary of the Farm

#### **Columbia County Aerial Parcel Map**

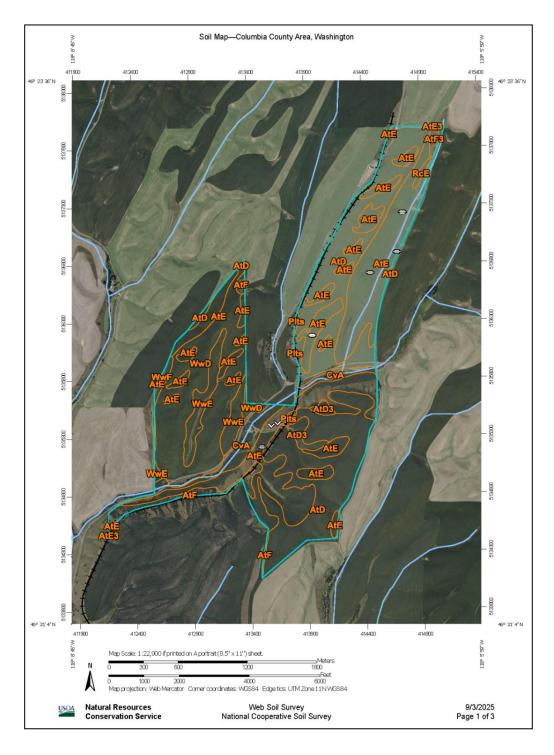

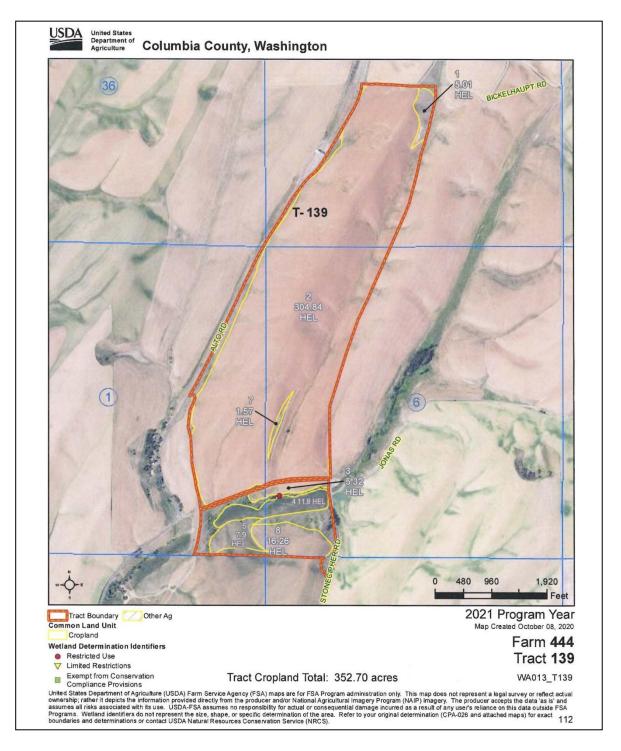


#### **Soils**

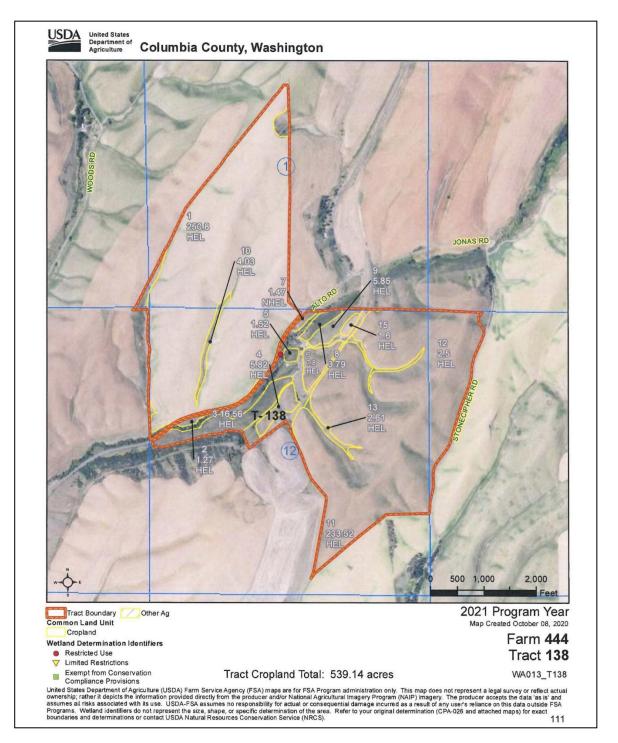
The predominant soil types are Athena silt loam, 25 to 40 percent slopes (AtE); and Athena silt loam, 8 to 25 percent slopes (AtD).

#### **Improvements**

There is a shop and barn located just off the east side of McKay Alto Road, approximately center of the farm.

The wood-framed shop, containing 1,200 square feet, has a concrete foundation and is metal clad, with sliding doors and a personnel door along the north side of the structure. The interior floors are concrete; walls have 6-foot-high plywood with the remainder exposed insulation; and the ceiling is unfinished. Heat is provided from a used oil stove.

The pole-framed barn, containing 2,070 square feet, has a concrete perimeter foundation; wood and metal siding; and a metal roof. The interior is unfinished and is used for storage.

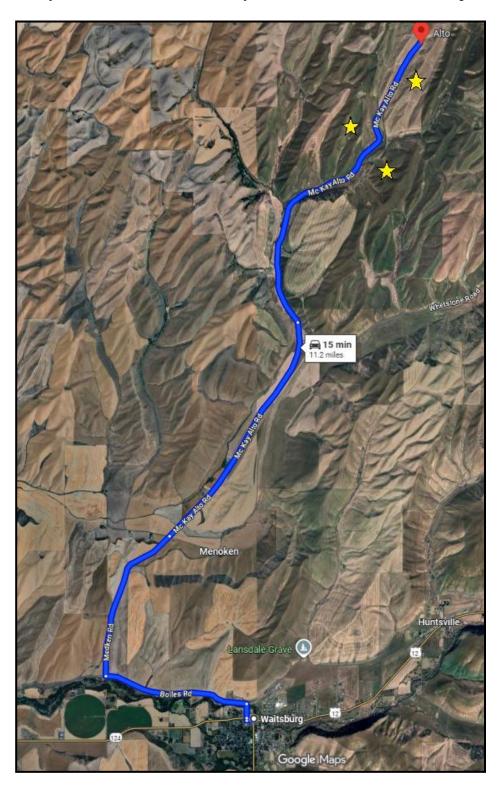




Shop Barn
