No such item shall be removed from the Property unless it is broken or destroyed. In the event such item is removed, it shall be replaced with a substantially identical item, if reasonably available. If not reasonably available, it shall be replaced with a substantially similar item of equal quality and value, or better. The same or newer model of the item being replaced in the same color and size and with the same functions or
