

### The Offering

#### **PROPERTY DETAILS**

Welcome to Pungo Farm Hunt Club, one of the oldest waterfowling properties in North America. Located along the famed Back Bay corridor, this is one of the most historically significant migration spots for waterfowl in the entire Atlantic Flyway. This offering is the first time in over a century the storied property has been offered to the public. This once-in-a-generation opportunity combines natural beauty, historical legacy, and premium waterfowl habitat in one of the most ecologically important waterways in the US. Pungo Farm Hunt Club is steeped in waterfowling lore. Back Bay, once dotted with exclusive duck clubs and historic blinds, has long drawn sportsmen from across the nation. This property is recognized as one of the oldest continually hunted tracts in the region, with hunting records and stories that date back well over a century.

In the golden age of gunning—when wooden decoys, sink boxes, and punt guns were the tools of the trade—Pungo Farm Hunt Club was already a revered destination. Its legacy is preserved in photographs, journals, stories, and log books, and is carried on through ownership today.













# History

#### **HISTORIC CLUBS**

At the convergence of Back Bay and the Currituck Sound, just south of Pungo Farm Hunt Club, was Live Oak Point. Currently it is the 8,200 acre Mackey Island National Wildlife Refuge, but in the early 20th century it belonged to Joeseph Knapp, the founder of Ducks Unlimited. It was along the marshes of the Currituck Sound and Back Bay where wealthy businessmen

from the New York and the northeast began travelling to for their waterfowl hunting outposts. The influx of waterfowl hunting in the late 1800s and early 1900s led to the founding of historic clubs such as the Princesse Anne Club, Pungo Farm Hunt Club, the Currituck Shooting Club, the Whalehead Club, and dozens more. Pungo Farm Hunt Club has been an active waterfowl club for almost a century with an

approximate founding in the year 1938. For most of Pungo Farm Hunt Club's history, it has been strictly marsh hunting, until an impoundment was constructed in 2008 to allow for a private waterfowl refuge on property. The club has continued to have rich success in waterfowl harvest even in years of mild weather due to centuries of imprinting to historic Back Bay and the Currituck Sound.




# Conservation & Stewardship
