### ABOUT THIS PROPERTY:

If you've been looking for the perfect hunting getaway that combines comfort, seclusion, and incredible habitat, this is it. Located just south of Lynch, Nebraska in Holt County, this 66± acre property checks every box for the serious outdoorsman.

The land is a beautiful mix of native warm-season grasses and timbered creek bottoms, offering that classic blend of cover and open views. Roughly 43 acres are in warm-season grasses that were once CRP, with the balance in mature timber and a home site that sits high above the valley. The rolling topography creates a scenic backdrop, with Redbird Creek winding through the bottoms, a natural travel corridor for deer and turkey that makes this place truly special.







### **More About this Property:**

Built in 2015, the 2-bedroom, 1-bath hunting cabin was designed with both comfort and views in mind. The cabin features a full kitchen, living area, and a wood-burning fireplace, perfect for relaxing after a day in the field. Step outside to a wrap-around wood deck that overlooks the entire property and the timbered creek valley below. It's the kind of view that makes you want to stay awhile. A 24 x 30 shop with concrete floors and power (built in 2023) provides plenty of space for ATVs, hunting gear, and equipment storage. The property also includes a private well, septic, and all the modern amenities to make your stay as comfortable as it is convenient.

Hunters will appreciate the fully irrigated 1± acre food plot, complete with a buried water line and sprinkler system tied into the house. It's a unique feature that will keep your plot green even in dry years, drawing in whitetails and turkeys from the surrounding properties. There is also a mix of planted apple, pear and chestnut trees, all fed from a drip line that you can control from your phone, giving this farm even more of a wildlife forage advantage.

This turnkey setup is ideal for someone looking for a ready-to-enjoy property with no work left to do. Whether you're after a weekend retreat, a family hunting camp, or a long-term investment in one of Nebraska's most scenic areas, this Redbird Creek gem delivers the best of all worlds.

Directions: From Lynch, go east on Hwy 12 just outside of the edge of town. Travel south on 503rd Ave for approximately 4.5 miles. Then go west on United Rd for 1 mile, turn south on 502nd Ave for 3/4 of a mile. The property is on the east side of the road.












#### **Aerial Map**




