BEING A 29.249 ACRE TRACT OF LAND LOCATED IN THE LEWIS KINCHELOE SURVEY, ABSTRACT 55, AUSTIN COUNTY, TEXAS, SAID 29.249 ACRE TRACT BEING THAT CALLED 29.295 ACRE TRACT RECORDED IN VOLUME 594, PAGE 720, OFFICIAL RECORDS OF AUSTIN COUNTY TEXAS, SAID 29.156 ACRE TRACT OF LAND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED BY METES AND BOUNDS AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING at a 1/2 inch iron rod found marking the southeast corner of the herein described tract, being also the southwest corner of a called 70.50 acre tract recorded in Volume 361, Page 427, Deed Records of Austin County, Texas, and lying in the North right-of-way (ROW) line of Coshatte Road;

THENCE N 79°26'43" W with the North ROW line of Coshatte Road a distance of 60.00 feet to a 5/8" inch iron rod set & capped "Explorer Group" marking the most southerly southwest corner of the herein described tract, being also the southeast corner of a 10.533 acre tract recorded in Volume 658, Page 652, Official Records of Austin County, Texas;

THENCE N 10°48'35" E with the East boundary line of said 10.533 acre tract a distance of 1241.33 feet

to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for an interior el corner of the herein described tract, being also the northeast corner of the said 10.533 acre tract;

THENCE N 79°11'01" W with the North boundary line of said 10.533 acre tract a distance of 360.15 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found at an angle point in the North boundary line of the said 10.533 acre tract;

THENCE N 52°17'11" W with the North boundary line of the said 10.533 acre tract, at 60.96 feet pass the northwest corner of the said 10.533 acre tract, being also the northeast corner of a 18.249 acre tract recorded in Volume 594, Page 277, Official Records of Austin County, Texas, and continuing along the North boundary line of said 18.249 acre tract for a total distance of 614.79 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for the most westerly southwest corner of the herein described tract, being also the northwest corner of the said 18.249 acre tract, and lying in the East boundary line of a 27.26 acre tract recorded in File No. 112278, Official Records of Austin County, Texas;

THENCE N 16°51'35" E with the East boundary line of the said 27.26 acre tract a distance of 287.52 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found for an angle point in said line;

THENCE N 19°18'13" E continuing with the East boundary line of the said 27.26 acre tract a distance of 771.17 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for the northwest corner of the herein described tract, being also the northeast corner of the said 27.26 acre tract, being also the southwest corner of a 138.36 acre tract recorded in File No. 091938, Official Records of Austin County, Texas;

THENCE S 72°17'08" E with the South boundary line of the said 138.26 acre tract a distance of 200.92 feet to a an iron stake found for an angle point in said line;

THENCE N 06°15'52" W continuing with the said South boundary line a distance of 4.03 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for an angle point in said line;

THENCE N 79°39'03" E continuing with the said South boundary line a distance of 672.95 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for the northeast corner of the herein described tract, lying also in the West boundary line of the said 70.5 acre tract;

THENCE S 10°53'18" W with the West boundary line of said 70.5 acre tract a distance of 1502.10 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for an angle point in said line;

THENCE S 10°47'31" W continuing with the West boundary line of the said 70.5 acre tract a distance of 1288.43 feet to the **PLACE OF BEGINNING** and containing 29.249 acres of land.
